6. Houston* -6 vs. Baltimore
7. Green Bay -5.5 vs. St. Louis*
8. Minnesota* -6 vs. Arizona
9. New England* -10.5 vs. NY Jets
10. Oakland* -4 vs. Jacksonville
11. Pittsburgh -2.5 vs. Cincinnati*
12. Chicago* -5.5 vs. Detroit

You should read the spreads as, for instance, that Buffalo will score 3.5 points more than Tennessee. Your choice should tell me which way you think the game will go - will the left hand side team beat the spread, meaning that they will score more points than what is predicted, or will they not? For instance, Buffalo will beat the spread if they score 4 points more than Tennessee. You can frame your choice as either choosing a particular team (a choice of Tennessee will note that your bet is that Buffalo will not beat the spread), or by just telling me whether or not the favored team will beat or not beat the spread.
