The Project

You are in two teams. One team will be researching Motifs, the other will be researching Rearrangements and Reversals. The main papers for each team are posted on Blackboard. Each team should divide the work within the team as evenly as possible.

The Paper

One person on each team will be responsible for explaining the contents of a paper to the rest of the team. As a part of the project, each team will develop a paper which provides executive summaries of the team's papers as well as a good overview of the topic for the team.

The Presentation

Each team will present their topic for the whole class. This presentation should include a description of their topic, as well as an in depth explanation of one of the algorithms. The presentation should last at least half an hour, but no more than one hour.

Evaluations

After both presentations, you will complete two evaluations: group evaluations and peer evaluations. Group evaluations will discuss your group's division of labor and its success. Peer evaluations will evaluate the other team's presentation and its educational success (whether or not you understood the algorithm and topic as presented).
